PhD, Professor of Architecture from 1989, and Co-ordinator of the Interdisciplinary Research Group on Suburbs, Laval University, Québec City, Canada. She holds a professional degree in architecture and a Master's of Science from the same university, as well as a Ph.D. in Environment-Behavior Studies from the University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee in the United States. She was the head of graduate programs in architectural sciences from 1996 to 2006, before taking over the direction of Laval University multidisciplinary Planning and Development Research Center (CRAD) until 2010. She is the co-founder of the Interdisciplinary Research Group on Suburbs (GIRBa) whose mission is to understand, imagine and act on aging suburbs in relationship with limited demographic growth, ongoing urban sprawl, car dependency and the necessity of sustainable development. Her research and teaching deal with residential environments and behaviours, and favours back and forth between fundamental research, action research, and design. Her work includes the development of processes aimed at bridging the gap between knowledge and practice, namely through consensus-building and participatory design.
