Dina Shehayeb is the principal of her private consultancy firm Shehayeb CONSULT as well as a professor at the Housing and Building National Research Centre (HBRC) in Cairo, Egypt. Graduated as an architect in 1984, she focused in her post-graduate degrees on Environment - Behaviour relations in Architecture, Urban Design and Planning. Specialized in trans-disciplinary research and practice, she works on bridging the gap between the physical environment and its socio-economic, cultural and psychological dimensions. Her research-based practice translates into culturally appropriate built environments and effective housing policies, passing through community-based neighbourhood upgrading and planning, conservation and revitalization of "living heritage" patterns. Consultancies both national and international often include being part of an interdisciplinary team of experts where her methods and outputs afford the integrative framework. Practice at Shehayeb CONSULT links theory to practice through empirical research and grounded theory generation with local communities. It recently focuses on research utilization in practice and policy making through the development of more usable tools and design guidelines. She is member of several committees and working groups both national and international institutions and has more than 30 publications in scientific journals, conference proceedings and international reports and books.
